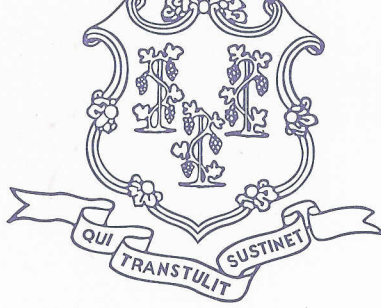

WHEREAS, The FFA promotes citizenship, volunteerism, patriotism and cooperation; and

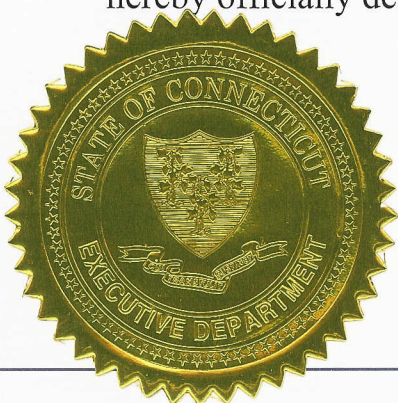
WHEREAS, the Connecticut FFA Association has provided agriculture education to the youth of Connecticut for over 76 years; and
